Most Christians are born to troubled families; a child will be cursed or blessed depending upon the life lived by the parents, grandparents, great-grandparents and the great-great-grand parents. **Exodus 20:1-5**

God has stated that He will show mercy and hand out blessings. verse 6

HOW TO RECOVER FROM FAMILY CURSES

- 1. A person must be born again before any recover is possible. John 3:3-8; 2 Corinthians 5:17-18
- 2. Obey the command of Jesus and be baptized in water by immersion. **Matthew 28:18-20**
- 3. Be baptized in the Holy Spirit. Acts 1:4-8; 2:1-4; 38-39; 19:1-6
- 4. Break all the curses listed in the Bible that pertain to you. Galatians 3:13-14
- 5. Cast out all the demons. Matthew 10:8; Luke 10:17-21
- 6. Receive your physical healing from God. Acts 10:38
- 7. Live a life of holiness and walk with Jesus on a daily basis. John 15:1-14

WHAT HAS GOD PROMISED?

God has promised to restore what the Devil has stolen if you repent of your sins and turn to Him with your heart. **Joel 2:12-27**

WE MUST BE PERSISTENT IN ASKING

Jesus told the parable of a friend who need bread at midnight. Luke 11:5-8

Webster's dictionary defines "importunity" as "urgent or persistent in asking, demanding, insistent, refusal to be denied, annoyingly urgent, troublesome, annoying."
