	The destruction of Lot's life began with strife. Genesis 13:1-12
	Lot moved to Sodom, totally disregarding that the city was evil. verse 13
	Lot could have stayed with Abraham and shared in the blessing from God, but temporary earthly benefits lured him away. verses 14-18
	In the beginning, Lot was honored in Sodom and became a judge. Genesis 19:1, 19:9
	Lot was so backslidden that he had lost sight of the fact that God was Almighty and the Creator, he felt that he had to protect the angels. In order to do so, he was willing to sacrifice his own daughters and allow them to be gang raped all night by the perverted homosexuals. verses 2-8
	The angels did not pay attention to Lot; they simply took control of the situation. verses 11-12
	Despite the warning from the angels, Lot and his wife did not want to leave Sodom; it was a city of comfort to them. verses 13-17
	Lot was more concerned about comfort than walking with God. verses 18-20 Lot moved into God's permissive will. verses 21-23
	Lot lost his wife. verses 24-26
	God saved Lot's life out of respect for Abraham. verses 27-29
	Lot finally went where God had intended for him to go but there were no more blessings for Lot. His two daughters committed incest with their father and as a result they bore two sons who were cursed and became the ancestors of two cursed nations, Moab and Ammon. verses 31-38
	Lot's testimony and credibility were stolen by the Devil; furthermore, he brought a curse upon his offspring which is still in force unless individuals accept Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour.
