THE GROOM & HIS BRIDE

The concept that Jesus is the groom and the church is His bride can be found in the New Testament in several places.

- John the Baptist explained his position in the kingdom of God. **John 3:23-36**
- Jesus referred to Himself as the bridegroom. **Matthew 9:14-15**
- In the Book of Revelation, there is the powerful teaching on the Marriage Feast of the Lamb. **Revelation 19:1-9**
- This is followed by two more strong statements in the Book of Revelation, where the church is referred to as the bride. **Revelation 21:2-9, 22:17**

SPIRITUAL ADULTERY

- The apostle James was given a strong revelation on the concept of Jesus as the groom and the church as the bride when he wrote a stinging rebuke to the believers who are not faithful to Jesus. **James 4:1-5**
- In the Old Testament, God speaks of going a whoring and committing whoredom. The concept here is that the people were not faithful to God since they were worshipping demon gods. Whether they realized it or not, behind these demon gods stood their master, the Devil.
