THE RESTORATION

Paul had been through a trial and hearing before Festus and King Agrippa and made an appeal to be heard before the Emperor of Rome. As a result, he was sent to Rome as a prisoner. Acts 26:24-32
There is no written record that Paul understood the gravity of his compromise or that he had repented and was restored. But just like the Apostle Peter was broken down, Paul must have gone through a similar process. Matthew 26:31-35, 69-75
Just as Jesus personally dealt with Peter, Paul must also have been ministered to by Jesus. John 21:1-19
My personal understanding is that Jesus took Paul back to the time of his salvation and made it clear to Paul what his role would be on this earth. Acts 9:8-18
