**PART 13: THE FIRST ADAM** 

In the history of mankind, the Bible talks about two Adam's, with each being unique and different from all other humans.

## THE FIRST ADAM

This man had no human parents. He was a created from scratch by the Creator, Jesus Christ. **Colossians 1:12-19**; **Hebrews 1:1-3** 

Adam was not created as a baby but a fully grown man. Genesis 2:7-17

Eve was also created, but instead of starting from scratch, Jesus performed surgery on Adam and used one of his ribs to create a full grown woman. Adam and Eve were never children. **Genesis 2:21-25** 

Both Adam and Eve were created sinless and had full access to Jesus, who frequently appeared to them, talked with them and gave them instructions. **Genesis 2:15-17, 3: 8-13** 

They were given a free will to obey or disobey Jesus, so He placed a testing object in the Garden. **Genesis 2:16-17** 

It was placed there in order for Satan to have something with which to tempt them. **Genesis 3:1-7** 

Once Adam and Eve sinned, they lost their innocence, their spirits died, and they became corrupted by sin; this corruption was passed on to the entire human race. **Romans 5:12** 

Instead of destroying them, God made a covenant with Adam and Eve about a future redemption. **Genesis 3:14-20** 

This covenant was made through the shedding of blood and God covering their bodies with coats of skins. **Genesis 3:21** 

Thus, the blood sacrifices were instituted and carried on until the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. **Genesis 4:1-5**; **Hebrews 9:22-26**
