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PART 3: JESUS ESTABLISHED THE LAW OF GOD

WITHOUT LAW THERE IS FAILURE

The Books of Enoch has three subjects: historical facts about the spirit world, revelations about heaven and the universe and prophecy about the future Redeemer.

Melchizedek was the king of Salem and a high priest for the true living God but the citizens of his kingdom were not able to stay true to the living God since they did not have the law of God. **Genesis 14:18-20**

Job had access to the Books of Enoch but his descendants were not able to stay true to the Living God of Heaven, they disappeared in history and were swallowed up by idolatry. **Job 1:1; 42:10-17**

Jethro, the priest of Midian and father-in-law of Moses had access to the Books of Enoch but the people he presided over did not have the law of God and their descendents were also overcome by idolatry. **Exodus 18:1**

When Abraham, Isaac and Jacob lived in Canaan, they did not have the laws of God and lied, cheated and stole from others. They had faith in the Redeemer and loved God but there was no moral stability in their lives and in the people around them.

- ❖ **Jacob - Genesis 27:5-27**

Before God could bring the children of Israel into the land of Canaan and form them as a nation, He had to give them his law. Exodus 34:1-6; 27-32

Heathen nations have cruel laws with no justice for the people! Proverbs 29:2

JESUS BUILT HIS KINGDOM ON THE LAWS OF GOD

Jesus set up his kingdom from the very beginning on the Law of God as he gave it to the people in what is known as the "Sermon on the Mount." **Matthew 5:1-10**

Jesus admonished His followers. **verses 11-16**

Jesus made it clear that He had not come to abolish the Law of God but to fulfill it. **verses 17-19**



In the remainder of the chapter and in chapters six and seven, Jesus modified the law given to Moses by making its requirement more demanding. It was not enough to keep the laws but to keep them with the right attitude of love and gratitude toward God. No man can do this in the flesh; it has to be done through the power of the Holy Spirit. **Romans 8:1-17**

Prior to the coming of Jesus, none of the believers in the Messiah had been born again. **John 7:37-39**

The Old Testament saints were given **MERCY** by God when they put their faith in the future Messiah and were given **GRACE** they did not deserve. **Romans 4:1-8**

Jesus kept preaching that a person must be born again. **John 3:1-10**

The majority of the people who had followed Jesus rejected His call for repentance and to live a holy life; they just wanted free food and health care for their physical bodies. **John 6:44-71**

Jesus demanded obedience. **John 14:15; 15:1-5**

Satan promotes lawlessness. **2 Thessalonians 2:1-12**

Jesus built His church on the foundation of the law which requires a payment for the penalty of sin. Although Jesus paid that penalty in full, He did not tell his followers to be lawless! Romans 6:23; Hebrews 9:11-26
