#### **SICKNESS**

Sickness has been the scourge of the human race since Adam and Eve sinned against God in the Garden of Eden and became cursed. **Genesis 3:16-19**

#### **HEALING WAS AN INTEGRAL PART OF JESUS' MINISTRY**

Jesus wanted to make sure His followers understood that preaching the Gospel of salvation was to be done as the sick were being healed. This is what He commanded the apostles. **Luke 9:1-2**

This is what He commanded 70 additional disciples. **Luke 10:1-2; 9**

After His resurrection, Jesus emphasized that healing was to be part of the ministry until His second coming.



You find this in the great commission. **Matthew 28:18-20**

The Gospel of Mark makes it very clear. **Mark 16:15-20**

Jesus had made it very clear to the apostle John. **John 14:11-15**

It was evident after the Day of Pentecost. **Acts 3:1-9**

Jesus healed all the people that came to him. **Acts 10:38**

Jesus has never changed. **Hebrews 13:8**
