In the four previous messages, we have established that God the Father and Jesus are one. Jesus also told the disciples that if they had seen Him, they had seen the Father. **John 14:9** 

As the Son of God, Jesus was faithful in all things to the Father. Hebrews 3:1-6

To learn the emotions, actions and thinking of God the Father, let's examine the track record Jesus left while He was on earth.

### JESUS THE REDEEMER

God the Father wanted to redeem mankind from its sinful condition and Jesus carried it out. **Colossians 1:9-22** 

Our heavenly Father wants all people to be saved. John 3:16

### JESUS THE HEALER

Jesus made a strong declaration that He was not only interested in saving mankind for eternity, but that He wanted us to receive healing for our souls and physical bodies while still on the earth. **Luke 4:14-21** 

Jesus healed the leper. Matthew 8:1-4

Jesus healed a servant to a Roman army officer. verses 5-13

Jesus healed a multitude of people. verses 14-16

### JESUS THE DEMON BUSTER

Jesus cast out demons from a man who was blind and dumb. Matthew 12:22-23

Jesus cast out the demons from a man that no one could control. Luke 8:26-33

### JESUS THE RAISER OF THE DEAD

Jesus was also known for raising people from the dead. This was a compassion shown not only to the dead person but also to their families:

- The young girl. Mark 5:35-43
- His friend Lazarus. John 11:1-45

#### JESUS THE PROVIDER

Jesus was concerned about salvation, people's health, setting them free from demonic bondage and raising people from the dead, but Jesus was also concerned that people had food to eat, and instead of raising money and then buying the food, Jesus simply created the food He needed to feed the hungry. **Matthew 14:13-21; 15:29-38** 



The works that Jesus did were commissioned by God the Father and thus we can conclude that the compassion that Jesus showed on earth is also the same compassion of God the Father. We should start to rejoice that we have a heavenly Father that loves us and His greatest desire is that all our needs will be met as we earnestly seek him and are willing to do His will on earth. **Matthew 6:31-34**
