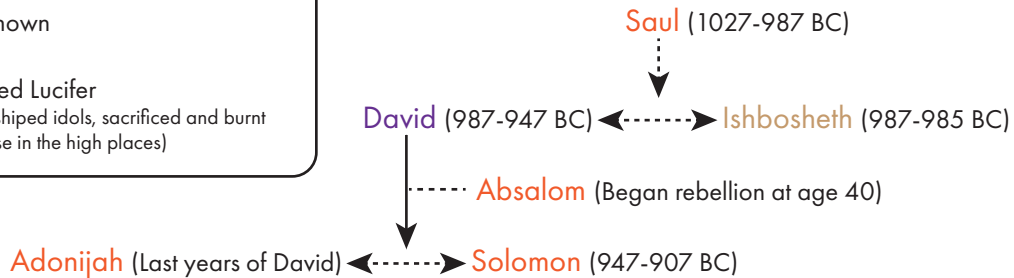


# The Kings of Unified Israel

■ Served God  
 (Did not get mixed up with any idolatry)  
■ Served God/Lucifer  
 (Initially served God, but then walked away)  
■ Unknown  
■ Served Lucifer  
 (Worshipped idols, sacrificed and burnt incense in the high places)

The years shown only reflect the time each king ruled and does not express the total time they lived.



It is important to note that idolatry and worship in the high places was introduced by Solomon.

Kingdom is spilt under Rehoboam's foolish policy of trying to be more harsh than his father.

God appoints Jeroboam to be king over the nine northern tribes, which forms the northern kingdom of Israel.

Rehoboam's harsh policy leaves him with just two tribes, which forms the southern kingdom of Judah.

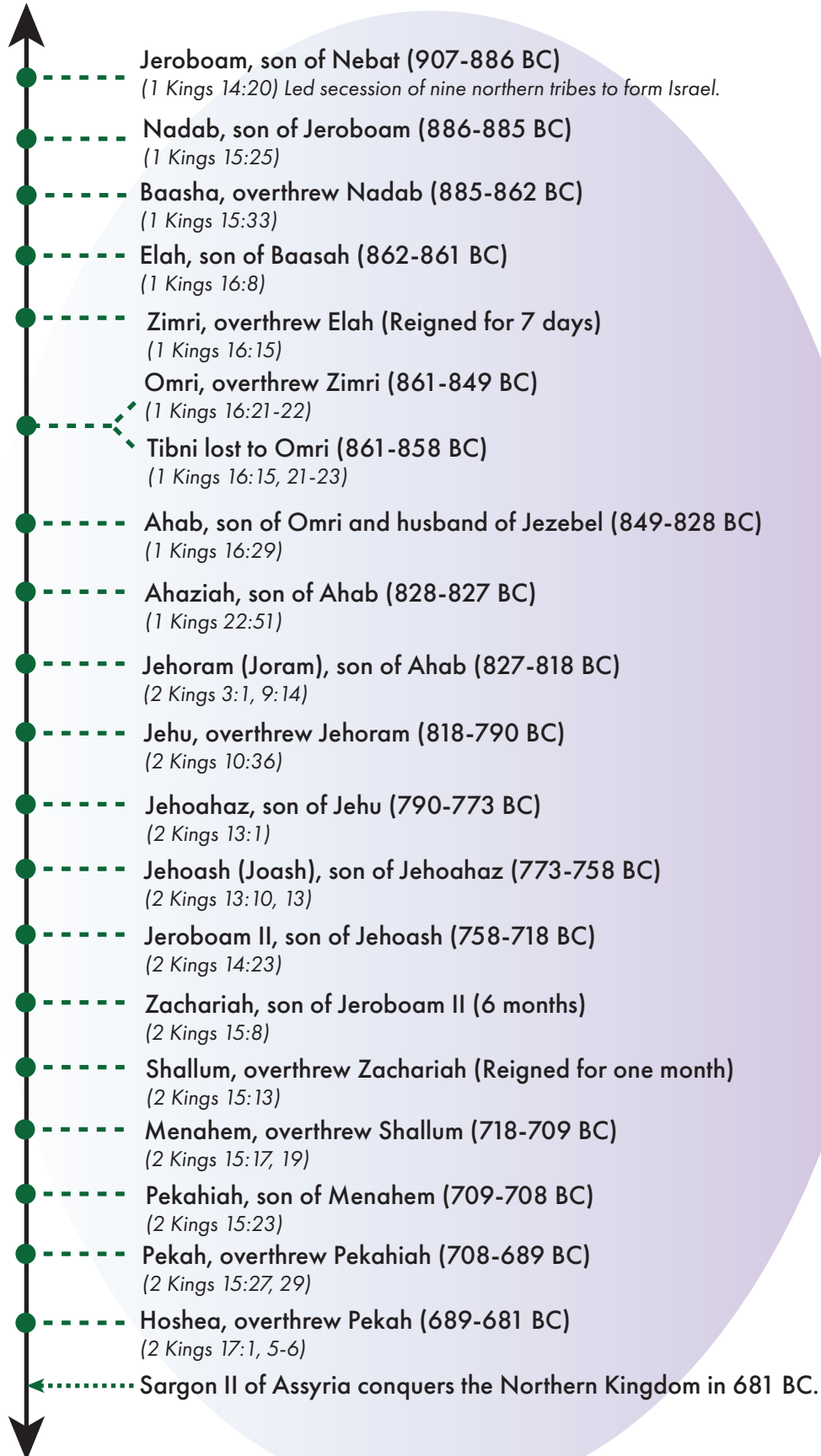
